Nursery staff are responsible of disinfecting the nappy changing areas in their own rooms and also their equipment, this is done in accordance with each rooms cleaning rota's.

Personal Hygiene and cleanliness:

Every member of staff should be aware of the important of personal hygiene.

Any staff who the management do not feel has maintained their personal hygiene will be familiarised with the policy and would be given the opportunity to address the situation with the management team.

Protective clothing

Nappy changing – White aprons and white gloves are provided for all staff these are also to be worn when cleaning up bodily fluids

Meal times – Blue aprons and blue gloves are provided for all staff to use when handling any food
